The MCRTA committee must receive all applications and supporting school principal or guidance counselor records by Monday, September 18, 2017. All applications and related information are to be mailed to the MCRTA Scholarship Committee, 32800 TR70, Lewisville, OH 43754. The award will be announced at the MCRTA fall luncheon meeting on Monday, October 30, 2017. Upon receipt of a letter from the recipient confirming enrollment in a qualified college (on or before Tuesday, October 10, 2017) a check in the amount of \$500.00 shall be presented at the MCRTA October meeting. ***(Please remember to complete all sections.)***
