SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Read the following carefully, if you do not complete all required information, do not send all required documentation (including your required photo) or do not submit by the designated time, you will be disqualified from consideration for a scholarship.

1. You must be a direct descendant of a Woodsfield High School or Monroe Central High School graduate alumnus, (mother, father, grandmother, grandfather, great grandmother, great grandfather).
2. Complete an application. Applications should be accompanied by a copy of your high school transcript that includes your overall GPA or a copy of your last grade report from the university or vocational training that you are attending. This should also include your overall GPA. You must have been accepted into a secondary institution for college or vocational training to qualify for a scholarship, include a copy of your acceptance letter if you will be a freshman.
3. Include a one (1) but not more than two (2) page type-written essay on the topic, "Chose an experience from your life and explain how it has influenced your choice of a career path." How has the experience helped you to determine your course of study? Do you plan on sharing your experience with other students as a means of influencing others to chose a career path? A scoring sheet is included to help you understand the criteria. You must have a score of at least 12 to qualify for a scholarship.
4. Please include a photograph for possible publication in the local news media. You may not use a photograph that has a studio name across the picture or has the work proof stamped on the picture. If you do not include a picture in the return packet, you will be disqualified. Photographs will not be returned.
5. Application, Photo and Essay must be received by May 15, 2017. In the spirit of fairness, no exceptions will be made after the deadline. Please have all required documents and pictures sent before the deadline. Do not email applications, essays, or pictures of applications.
