The ABGPA Midstream Scholarship Committee is composed of a minimum of three members appointed by the Board of Directors. Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee, which will recommend qualified nominees to the Board of Directors.

The Scholarship Committee will evaluate applications based on merit of students who, through academic and extra-curricular activities, demonstrate a desire to succeed, a commitment to making a positive contribution to others and whose applications substantiate the minimum requirements noted below.

Applicants must meet the following qualifications:

1. Student must demonstrate a strong interest in joining the oil and natural gas midstream industry.
2. Students must currently be enrolled as a full time student (at least 12 credit hours) at a partner school or school within the Appalachian region (Scholarship Committee will determine if the student from the non-partner school qualifies after receipt of application) and at least in the second year of a two-year or four-year undergraduate degree program with a focus on the oil & gas industry.
3. Current members and students who are ABGPA Midstream members must be in good standing and have held a membership for at least one year prior to applying.
4. Sponsored students of ABGPA Midstream members must be child, stepchild, grandchild, sibling, spouse, or niece/nephew.
5. Student must possess a grade point average of 2.8 or greater on a 4.0 scale. Proof or verification of GPA may be requested by the Scholarship Committee.
6. Student must be a US Citizen.

Scholarship applications for the 2020 school year must be emailed to scholarships@abgpa.org before midnight June 30th, 2020. The ABGPA Midstream Scholarship Committee will review the applications and award by August 1st, 2020. You will find the 2020 Scholarship application on our web site Scholarship page.
