OSCA Undergraduate Scholarship Application

The Ohio School Counselor Association Undergraduate Scholarship will be awarded each year to an outstanding high school senior. The scholarship is a one-time \$500 award.

Criteria for Eligibility

- Currently accepted to attend an Ohio private or public 4-year institution in the state of Ohio
- Maintains at least a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 grading scale
- Attend an OSCA member high school (Just one HS counselor needs to be a member to qualify, please check with your counselor to verify that your high school is an OSCA member.

Completed applications with supporting documents must be <u>uploaded to the OSCA awards site</u> <u>by April 30</u> each year. The website is: http://www.ohio.schoolcounselorawards.org/scoy/. Incomplete/late applications or those determined to not meet the above criteria will not be considered. The application must include the following support documents:

- 1. Completed scholarship application form (see below)
- 2. A typewritten essay of no more than one double-spaced page answering the following question: "How did a school counselor positively impact you?"
- 3. Copy of high school transcript

The scholarship will be awarded after completion of one semester. Student must submit to OSCA a copy of their first semester grade card as verification. Scholarship payment will be sent directly to the school. Grade cards can be sent to shawngrime@ohioschoolcounselor.org.
